Cst. David Wynn was born in Newcastle, New Brunswick on October 18, 1972. Cst. Wynn entered training with the RCMP at Depot Division on February 2, 2009. He graduated and was sworn in as a regular member of the RCMP on July 20, 2009. Upon graduation, he was posted to the St. Albert Detachment, St. Albert, Alberta. St. Albert Detachment was Cst. Wynn's first posting and he was serving there at the time of his death.

In addition to Cst. Wynn's regular duties at the St. Albert detachment he was a trained DARE (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) instructor. Dave embraced this role at the Keenooshayo Elementary School in St. Albert and left an indelible impression on his students. Prior to joining the RCMP, David worked in the Emergency Services Field as a trained paramedic for thirteen years. He worked in the town of Bridgewater on Nova Scotia's south shore. David maintained a leadership role as a Senior Operations Paramedic and was proficient in teaching First Aid, CPR and First Responder programs.

Before joining the RCMP in 2009, David and his wife, Shelly owned a small business, which provided courses in First Aid and CPR. For many years prior to joining the RCMP, David was involved with the implementation and development of Red Cross programs in Nova Scotia including providing training to future instructors. Growing up in New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, David held many interests and hobbies.

He enjoyed life-guarding growing up and became an avid scuba diver. His passion for he outdoors grew alongside the Miramichi River as his father taught him the peaceful art of fly fishing; A passion that David has passed down to his children.

Cst. David Wynn was shot on January 17, 2015 In St. Albert Alberta while on duty conducting an investigation into a stolen vehicle. He succumbed to his injuries on January 21, 2015. Cst. David Matthew Wynn is survived by his wife Shelly, sons, Matthew, Alexander and Nathan, and his mother, Catherine Wynn.
